

Replacing an E-Clip on Floating E-Clip Style Pin Tools

In the rare event that an e-clip falls off, please refer to these instructions for replacement:

- 1. Grab the E-clip with needle nose pliers.
 - a. The jaws of the pliers should be just at the edge of the E-clip, leaving the center open.
 - b. Position the E-clip so that the shiny, somewhat rounded side of the E-clip is facing up.
- 2. Line up the groove on Pin with the slot of the E-clip.
- 3. Press the Pin into the E-clip so the groove slides inside the opening of the E-clip.
- 4. Make the sure E-clip is secure and straight in the groove.
